

COMPOSITION OF THE FP NETWORK








EXCHANGE OF SCIENTIFIC INFORMATION

No. requests sent through the FP Network




No. of documents uploaded on IEP/year



No. meetings FPs with (potential) Art. 36 org.







% of execution of activities in 2015/FPs








EXPERT COOPERATION

% of Execution of Activities in 2015




% of Execution of Activities in 2015/FPs







TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES IN RA








COORDINATION OF SCIENTIFIC NETWORKS

% of Execution of Activities in 2015/FPs










INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION


% of Execution of Activities in 2015/FPs

CONCLUSIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS FOR 2016

- Higher rates of FP activity on Art. 36 and SNs
- Apparent lower rate of activity on information exchange (due to phase out of IEP), still, high email exchange
- > Compliance with mandatory activities (new template)
- Contribute to identify (new) tools for information exchange - pilot to start in EFSA in 2016 (with FPs)
- > Very good FP work on the G&P domain further promotion of submission of applications and consortia
- > Continue national pooling of expertise and, where possible, use EDB information before phase out of tool
- > Further promote EFSA and the work of FPs via (wider) events and make best use of available EFSA/FP material
- Further <u>support RA training activities</u>; make better <u>use</u> of available training material
- Further streamline interaction and information exchange between AF, FP and SNs – make use of available guidelines
- Improve information exchange on international cooperation
