

Highlights for European and international activities in 2016



The formalisation of **relations** (signing of cooperation agreements) with foreign partners. Continuing international visits to countries where collaborations are to be developed and countries with existing regular contacts to be maintained.



Continuing work on a **comparative analysis** of the strategies and organisation of laboratory activities in Europe, both for research and reference activities.

Initiative for a comparative analysis on toxicovigilance in Europe or internationally, and on plant protection products.



European research and innovation funding programme **Horizon 2020**: ANSES's first participation, in a European Joint Program (EJP), within a consortium of French public health agencies and research institutions, in EHBMI (if the proposal is selected).



The European and international **reference activities** of the laboratories remain a priority: ANSES has 9 European and 19 international mandates.



The organisation of a **high-level conference** for the 10 years of national environmental and occupational health research programme (PNREST).



As part of the European ERA-ENVHEALTH network, ANSES hosted in February 2016 a **workshop on foresight and emerging risks**, with national agencies from several European countries.
