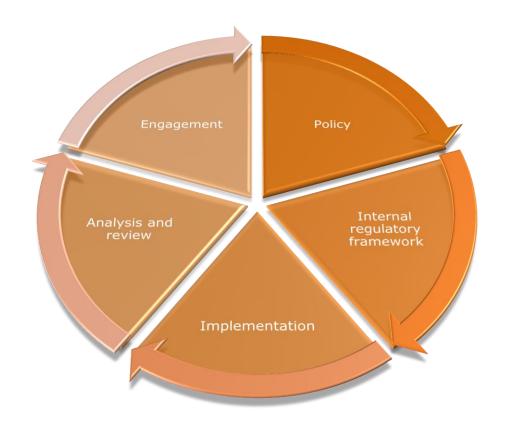

2011 POLICY IMPLEMENTATION

DoI Rules effective and costly

750.000 EURO and 7.200 DoI screened each year
