






THE ADVISORY FORUM

- Established under Art 27 of Founding Regulation
- 30 Members (28 MSs, Iceland, Norway); 6 Observer countries and EC
- Operating Procedures to be specified and made public
- **■** The roles of members:

Advise ED on work programme;
Pool knowledge and exchange information;
Avoid duplication of scientific studies/research;
Cooperate where scientific divergence is identified;
Promote European networking through Art. 36 organisations;
Ensure close cooperation on identification of emerging risks.

EXISTING DECISION

- Agreed by the Management Board in March 2008
- Covers aspects of Art 27 only
- Very descriptive (e.g. organisation of meetings and related procedures)





- **Recommendation from 2015 Review:**
- include more detail on roles specifically relating to scientific divergence
- **Objectives of the revision of the Decision:**
 - Detail scope of operation (not just the mechanics of meeting);
 - **Provide more detail on roles of members;**
 - Strengthen engagement.





MAIN CHANGES

- Less repetition
- Reference to translation removed
- Less on procedures (reimbursements, transparency and confidentiality)

- More structured
- Art 30 (scientific divergence) structured approach
- Art 36 (scientific cooperation and networking) – opportunities for more responsibilities for MSs





- Draft tabled at 60th Advisory Forum meeting (8-9 June)
- Management Board asked to provide comments on the draft
- Final Draft Decision to be tabled for adoption by the Management Board in October 2016
