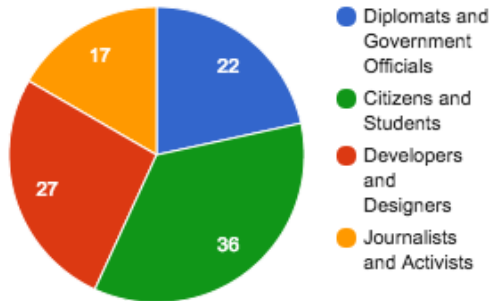




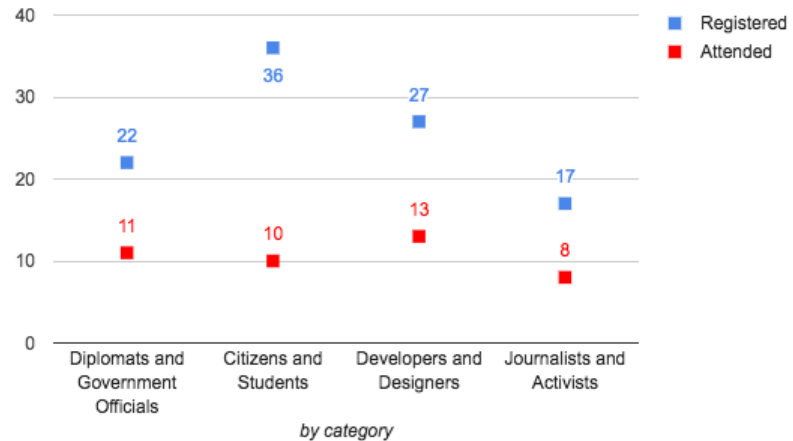
Registered vs Attended

Overall show-up: 42/102 hackers - 41% show-up rate

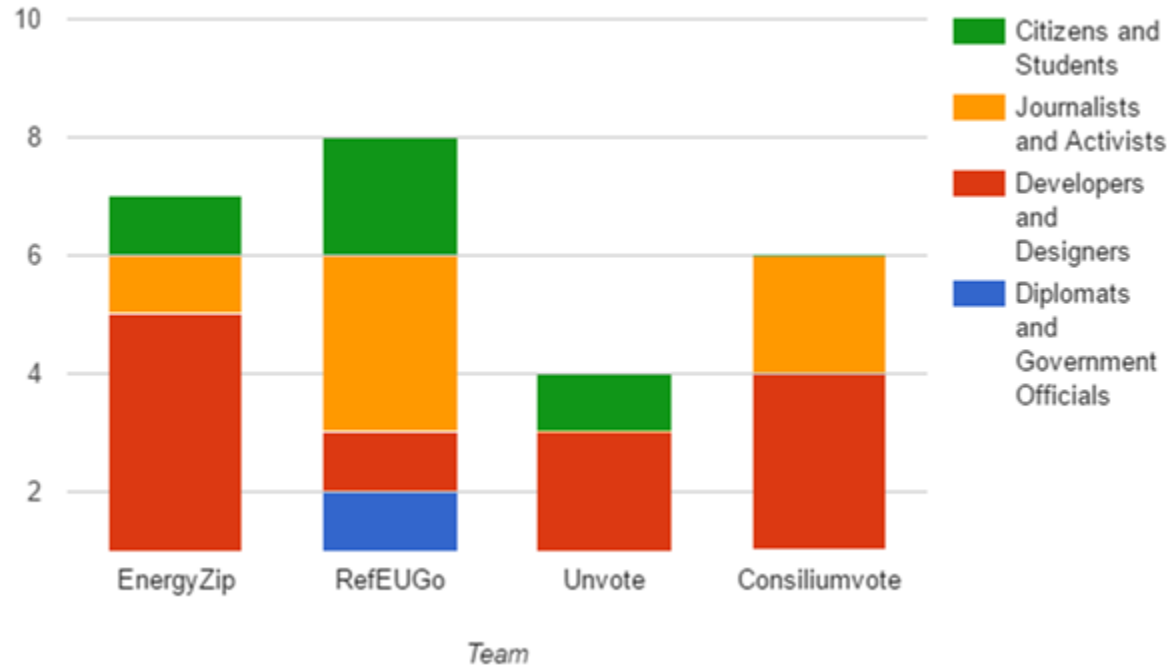
Registered participants per profile

How were the teams formed?



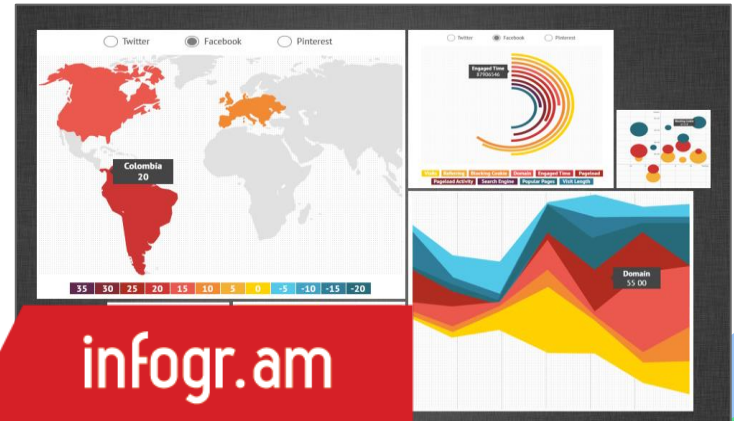
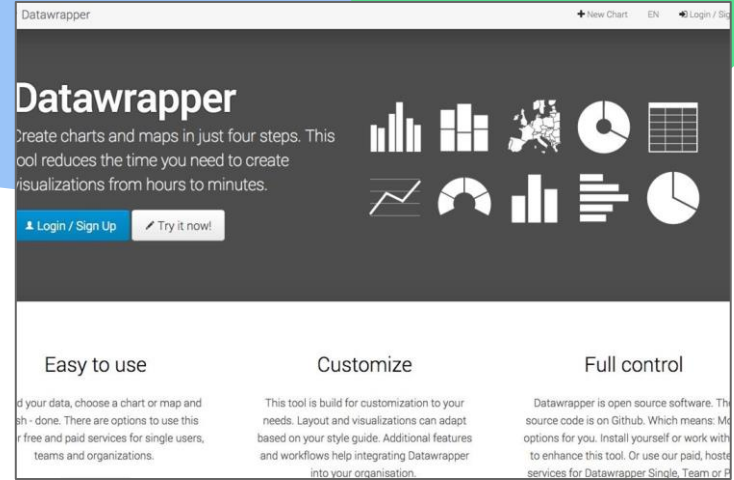

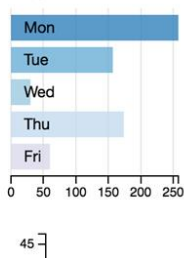
