



HEV surveillance systems in EU/EEA, 2015



 These gaps both in science have contributed to the lack of clear risk intervention strategies/ policy decisions




Workshop Outputs:

- Act as a platform to *inform policy interventions* at a high level to discuss and agree on a policy plan to mitigate any risk to health.


Is HEV seen as a serious public health risk? Use the relative scale from 1(negligible) to 5 (very serious)


