


### Feedback from participants

Overall, participants were satisfied with the way the event was organised (positive rates above **95%**), both on content and logistics.


**Table 1 | Logistics and Administration**




**Table 2 | Information and Communications**




**Table 3 | Content of the Event I**




**Table 4 | Content of the Event II**

Also the FP link to the EU RAA & Delphi study could be made clearer namely on next steps to make the projects happen.	Include in the agenda more strategic items and "real RA topics".
