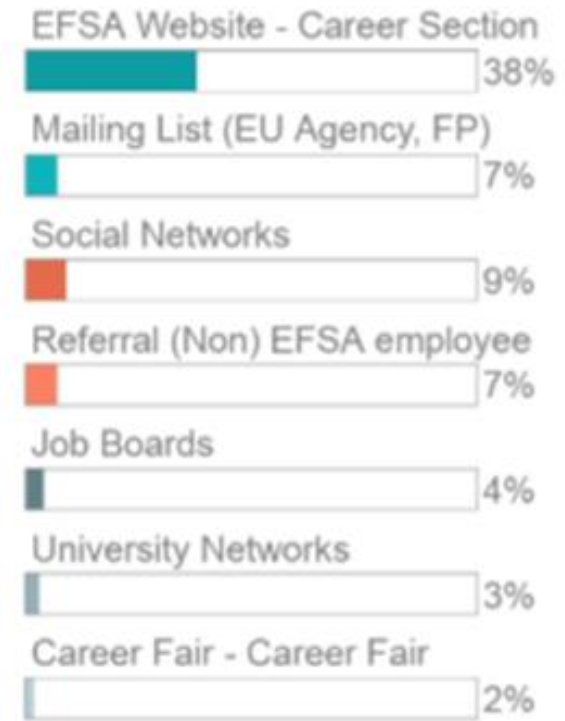

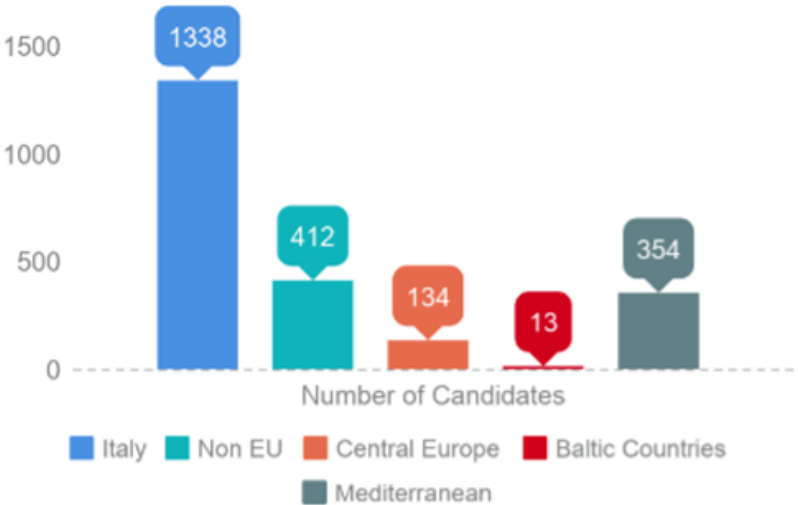

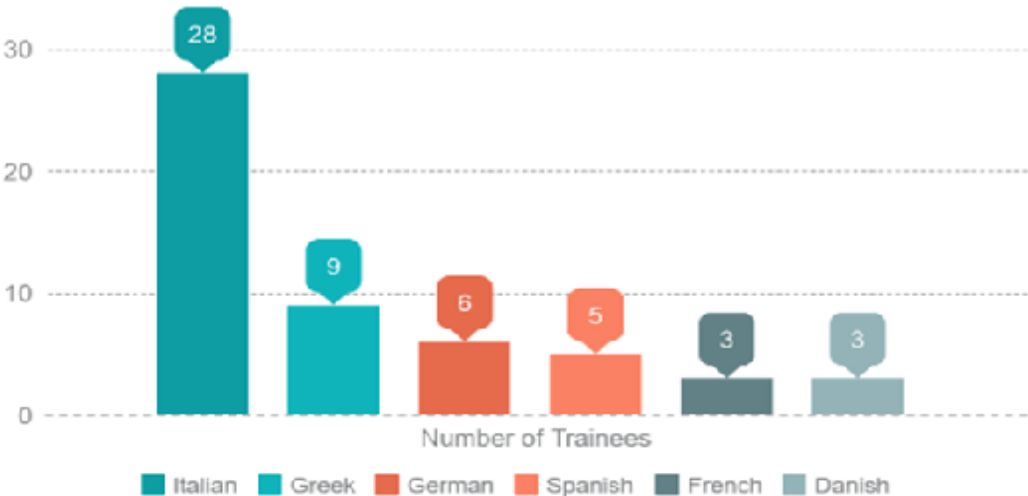

3. Invitation to interview: selected candidates invited to phone / Skype / recorded video interview

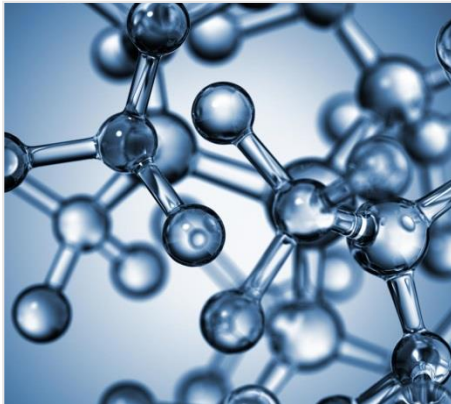


4. Positive outcome of selection process: placement offer – reserve list



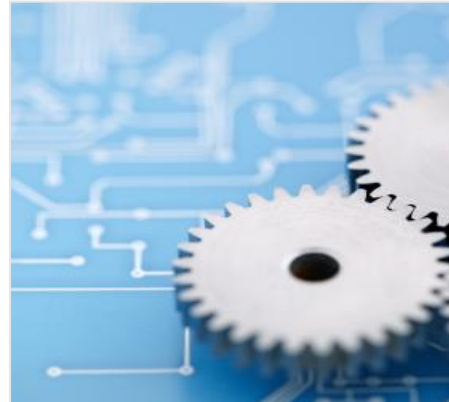
5. Confirmation of traineeship: following submission of required documents

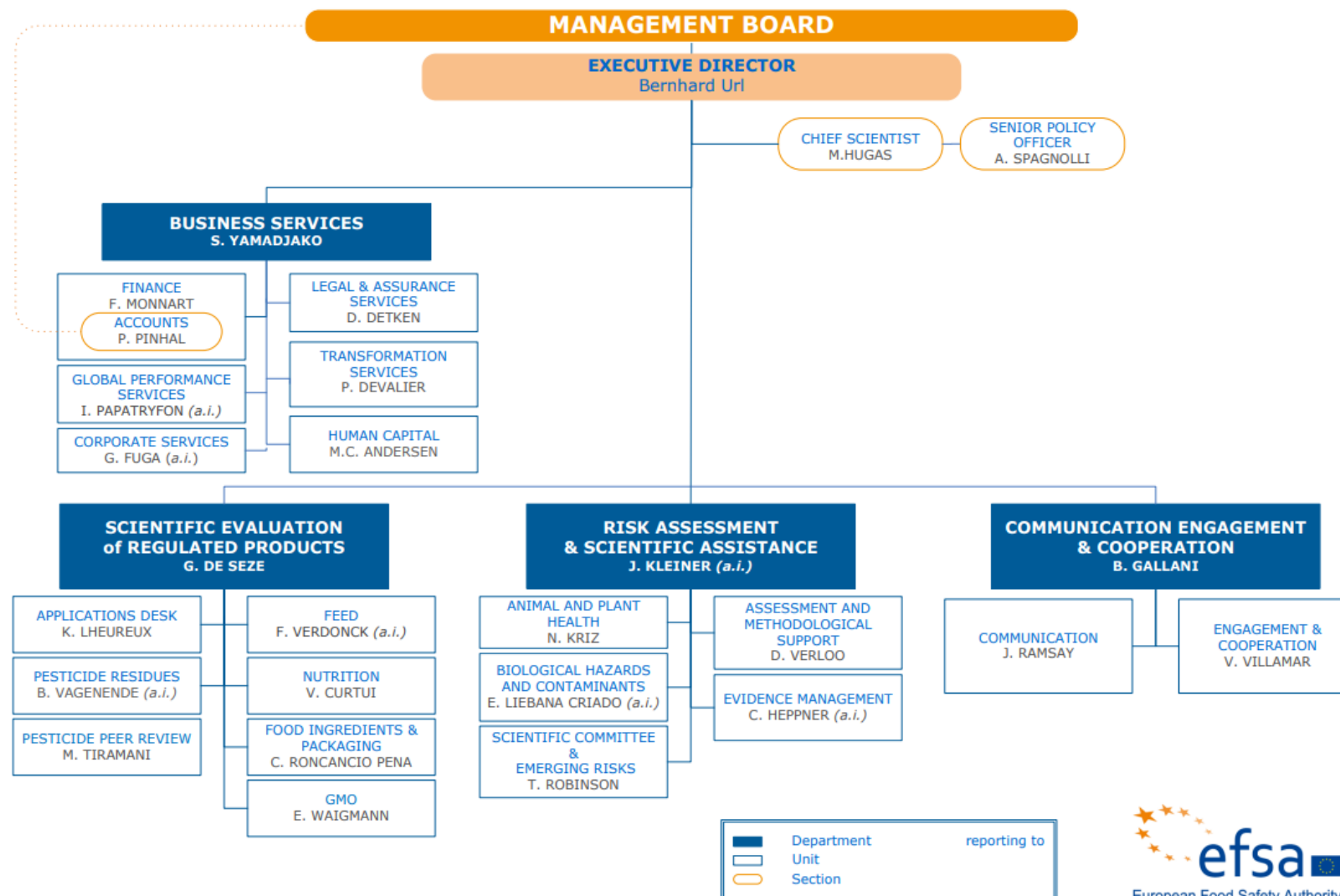

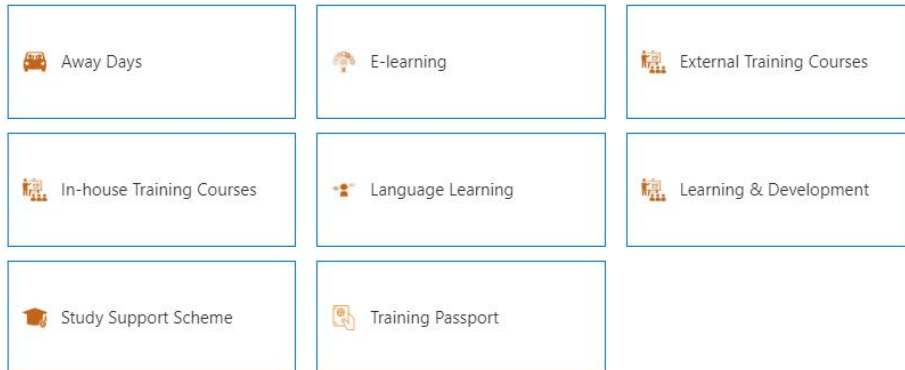
EFSA's ORGANISATIONAL CHART

Organisational Structure on 01/05/2019

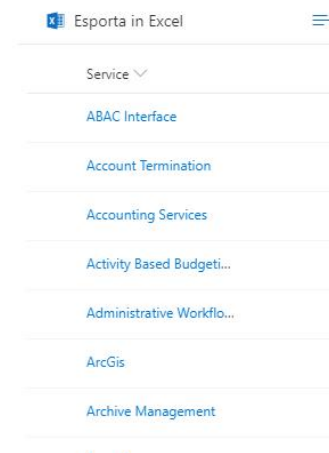

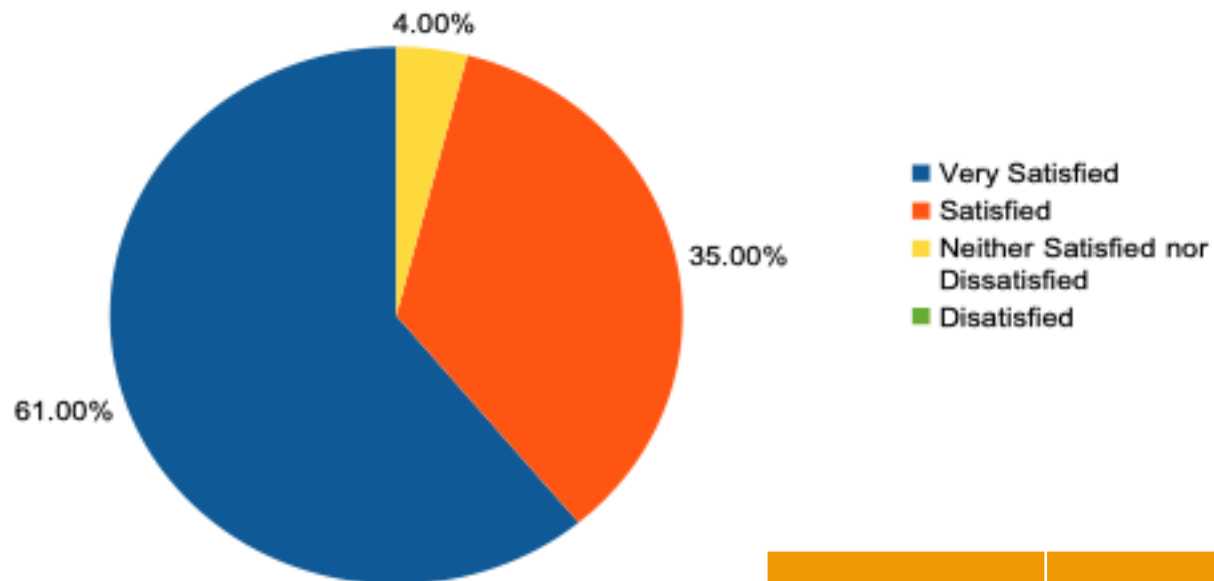
