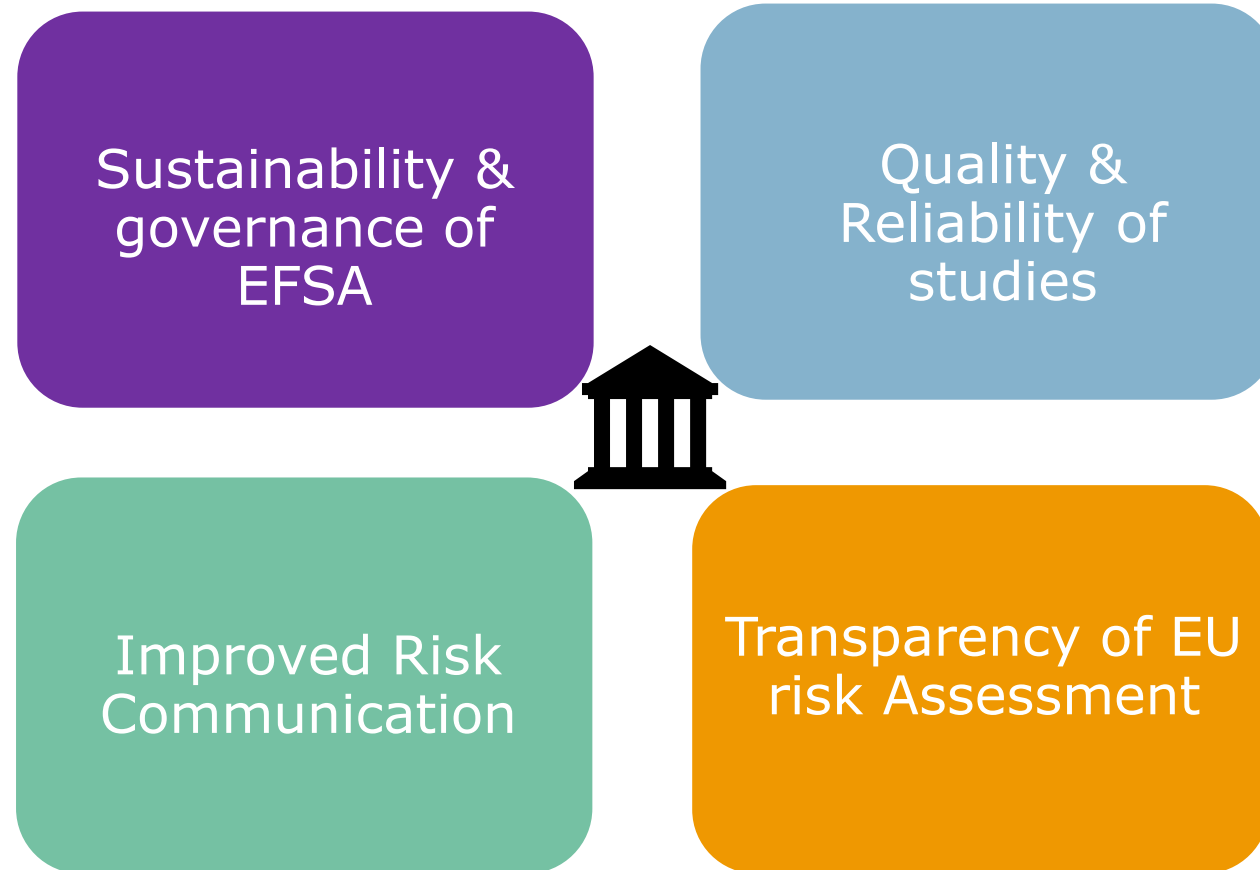

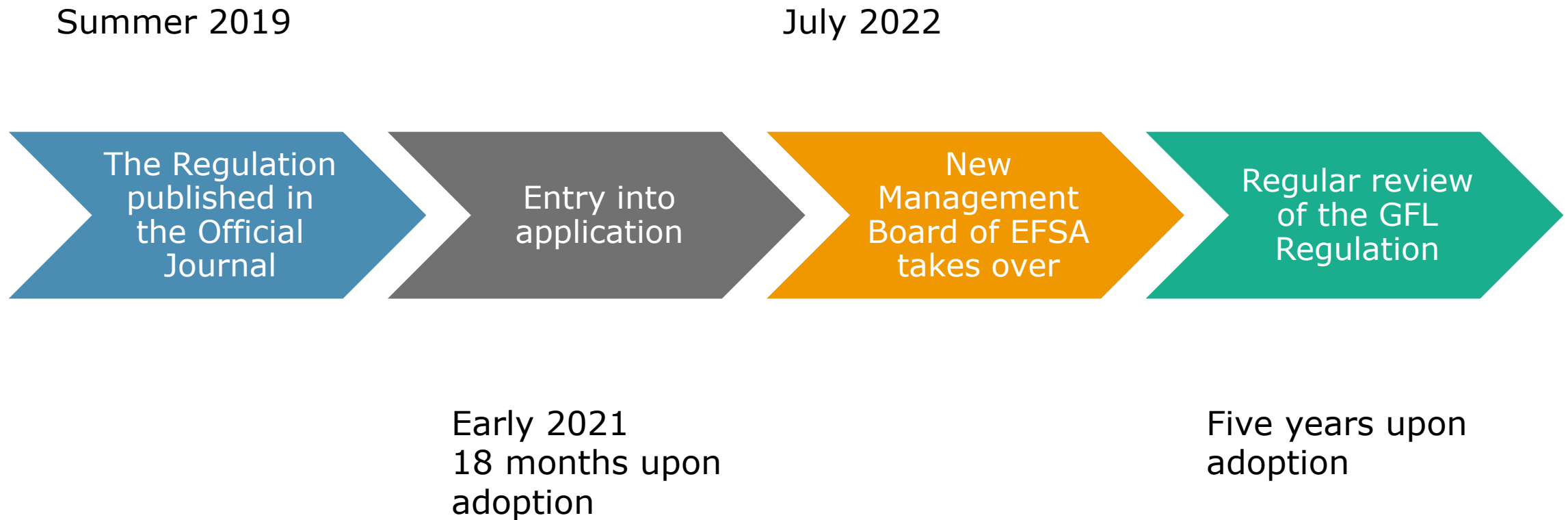

Four Pillars





Implementation - Program Planning

It aims at identifying and setting up all supporting measures to implement Regulation 178. It will provide efficient services to staff and experts targeting the 178 revised processes and the foreseen staff increase.

End2End Support Services



It aims to implement tasks deriving from Regulation 178 related to confidentiality decision-making, on reactive transparency under Public Access to Document and Aarhus regulation and the new Management Board.

Governance



It aims to redesign EFSA organigramme, aligning it to optimized processes, thus facilitating the implementation of Regulation 178 and EFSA Strategy 2027.

Organisational Design

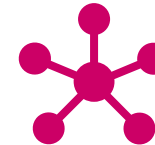


End2End Science

It aims to implement new Regulation 178 measures into all science processes from End-to-End. It also addresses future risk assessment challenges through an optimisation of these processes ensuring integration of scientific developments, harmonisation, efficiency and responsiveness.

Engagement and Communication

It aims at developing engagement and partnering mechanisms with EFSA's Stakeholders, required to support the new science approach and the implementation of a general plan for risk communication, in support of Regulation 178. It will provide communication tools and processes for the delivery of consistent messages.
