

## Management Board Meeting

### PRELIMINARY DRAFT BUDGET & ESTABLISHMENT PLAN 2009

Under Article 43 paragraph 5 of the Authority's Founding Regulation, the Management Board shall establish EFSA budget for the following financial year. The preliminary draft budget, the Establishment Plan and the provisional work plan, shall be forwarded by 31 March at the latest by the Management Board to the European Commission.

The Preliminary Draft Budget 2009 (PDB 2009) has been prepared within the framework of the financial perspectives 2007 – 2013.

#### ACTIVITY BASED BUDGETING

The PDB 2009 were elaborated along the ABB (Activity Based Budgeting) methodology which aims at identifying and allocating the financial resources required and the costs incurred to each of the activities conducted. As for 2008, four main activities were defined:

- Activity 1: Provide scientific opinion and advice to the European Commission, the European Parliament and the Member States
- Activity 2: Enhance risk assessment methodologies in Europe
- Activity 3: Communicate scientific advice and dialogue with interested parties
- Activity 4: Manage and provide administrative support

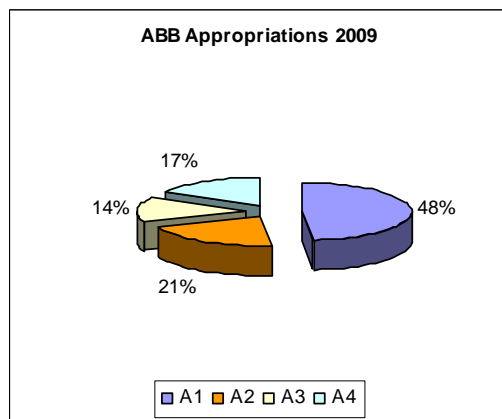
The internal organisation of EFSA mirrors these activities conducted by the four Directorates: Risk Assessment, Scientific Cooperation and Assistance, Communications and Administration.

The Preliminary Draft Budget 2009 does not include at this stage the outturn 2007 (estimated at EUR 2.0 million) nor the 2009 contribution of DG ENLARG to the enlargement program (estimated at EUR 0,5 million).

The PDB 2009 amounts to EUR 73.0 million ie: a 15% increased compared to 2008 (EUR 63.5 million without outturn and DG ENLARG contribution). This increase does reflect both the staff recruitment in 2008 and 2009 and the increase in operational activities. Compared to the 2007 execution, this represent an increase by 54 % (EUR + 25. 6 million) mostly devoted to the increase of activities in the two scientific directorates ( EUR + 20 millions).

In terms of ABB, the commitment appropriations 2009 spread as follows:

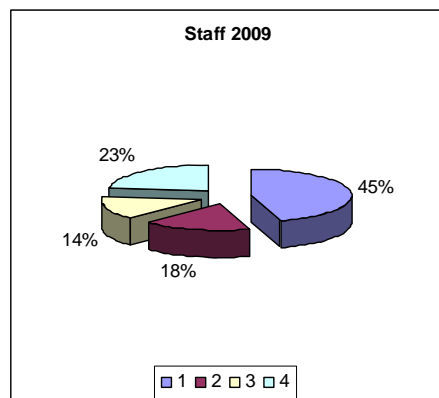
The personnel and infrastructure expenditure are allocated to each activity proportionally to their headcount. In addition, each of the three operational activities also has its direct operational costs.

The Scientific activities (Activity 1 & 2) would therefore represent 69 % of the budget, the Communication and Dialogue activities 18 %. The administration part would represent 17 % of the 2009 budget

## ESTABLISHMENT PLAN

With regards to the Establishment Plan, the requirements in Officials and Temporary staff (355) are in line with the financial perspectives. The distribution of posts in the 2009 establishment plan reflects the objectives stated in the Staff Policy Plan, out of the 20 new temporary agents, 14 posts, (ie: 70%) have been allocated to the Risk Assessment and the Scientific Cooperation and Assistance Directorates.

In addition to the Officials and Temporary staff, Contractual Agents (80) and National Detached experts (20) will complete the Human resources.

Whereas the Scientific activities would be allocated 63 % of the work force, 14 % would be devoted to Communication and Dialogue and 23 % to Administration.

## BUDGET BY TITLE

Compared to 2008, the main differences by Titles are the following:

The personnel expenditures increase is due to the impact of the 2008 recruitments (about 100 additional staff) and also to the new 2009 posts (43).

Under Infrastructure, the increase is related to the building and the IT equipment corresponding to investments to improve business processes.

Within operations, EUR 16.2 million or 67 % of the operational credits will be allocated to Scientific meetings (EUR 9.9 million), Science contracts (EUR 3.2 million) and grants (EUR 3.1 million).

The increase compared to last year has been shared over all panels secretariats and additional resources have been dedicated to scientific cooperation (EUR + 0.4 million) and emerging risks (EUR + 0.2 million).

It should be highlighted that the EUR 21.4 million envelop for operations should be increased by EUR 1.3 million (estimated 2007 operational outturn) when adopting the final Budget in December 2008.

## DIFFERENTIATED APPROPRIATIONS

Starting from 2009 and in order to better manage the payment appropriations, differentiated appropriations are introduced under Title III (operations). The principle is to spread over different budget years the payments covering multi-annual projects. In total, the payment appropriations cover the budget commitment appropriations but are recorded within the following budget years where the payments have to be made.

Under Title III, the grants and contracts launched under the Activities 1 and 2 may have execution periods spanning over more than two budget years. Therefore the introduction of differentiated appropriations for the budget lines covering these grants and contracts will allow optimisation of the payment appropriations and trigger closer treasury management.

The preliminary draft budget and Establishment Plan 2009 hereunder are submitted to the Management Board for adoption.
