The review



- EFSA's MB agreed in June 2005 to set up a Stakeholder Consultative Platform.
- EFSA's MB decision in September 2006 to extend the mandate with the objective to review the ToR and the membership after three years of operation.
- 3 years ending mid September 2009.
- EFSA's MB invited to consider and decide on the draft ToR which include a renewal of the mandate for further 3 years.

The process



- Overview based on:
 - → the outcomes of the Qualitative Research Report issued in March 08
 - → the recent discussions/comments at the SHP in the wake of the possible renewal of the mandate
- ToR developed in the context of the Platform:
 - → tour de table at the SHP meeting of 5/6 March 08
 - → consultation of the SHP and compilation of written comments by the Chair in April/May 09
 - → final discussion at the SHP meeting of 4/5 June 09

Draft Terms of Reference



Draft includes changes proposed by the Platform:

- Scope of work
- Objectives set for the next mandate
- Clarifications on the nature and balance of members
- Selection via public call
- Renewal option of the Chair and Vice-Chairs
- Criteria for members
- Associated members
- Number of meetings per year

Possible next steps



- Two public calls for expressions of interest launched early July 2009
- List of member organisations and associated membership to approve at the October 2009 MB meeting.
- First meeting in November 2009 of the renewed Platform
