# **Legislation - Regulation (EC) No 178/2002**



- Art. 22.7 and Art. 23, lit. g: <u>network</u>s in which all Member States are present
- Art. 36 and Commission Regulation (EC) No 2230/2004: <u>networking</u> with specific organisations on the art. 36 list

### Aim of networks



#### With all Member States:

### Facilitate scientific cooperation framework by

- the coordination of activities
- the exchange of information
- the development and implementation of joint projects
- the exchange of expertise and best practise in the field within EFSA mission

## Creation and composition of Networks



- EFSA may create and operate Networks in consultation with the AF on specific areas
- Networks shall be composed of organisations from <u>EU Member States</u>
- Other organisation (3<sup>rd</sup> countries, international) may be invited

## **Appointment of members of networks**



- Members shall be <u>appointed by the competent</u> <u>organisation</u> designated by EU Member States
- Appointed for a period of three-year period

## Organisation of the work of networks



- Networks <u>chaired</u> by EFSA
- EFSA shall provide <u>secretariat</u> to networks
- The secretariat of Network shall ensure that the <u>AF</u> and SC are informed on the activities
- Confidentiality: required
- <u>Dol</u>: encouraged
