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REVISION OF MANAGEMENT PLAN 2011

The Management Board has adopted the 2011 Management Plan in December 2010. EFSA is now about 3/4 of the execution of its 2011 work plan and is reaching definitive conclusions of the incoming requests, necessary prioritisation, stop the clock mechanisms and grouping of mandates and outputs. All these factors will have an impact on the outputs target of EFSA.

With this document EFSA submits to the Board a revised 2011 Management Plan, for its output targets (table 1) and asks for its adoption.

The output targets in the MP 2011, as adopted by the Board in December 2010, was 847 and the target expected to be reached by the end of 2011 will be 693.

Comments

ANS (- 20 outputs): Additional data not received by the applicants or interested parties for the re-evaluation of food additives through public calls for data; Shift of priorities due to finalisation on new guidance on food additives and re-evaluation of Aspartame (agreed with EC)

FEED(- 39 outputs): Several applications are under stop the clock procedure; Different grouping of mandates at EC level and consequent grouping of outputs by EFSA

PESTICIDES (- 73 output): Late publication of regulation 188/2011; application under stop the clock procedure; Reception of "urgent requests" from DG SANCO causing shifting of priorities and staff

PLH (- 6 outputs): mandates not received from the EC and reprioritisation in agreement with EC

SAS: (-11outputs): increased production of internal reports in assistance to other units, different grouping of outputs

CONTAM: (- 3 outputs): changes in the procurement calls following decision taken at panels level and to avoid duplication at MS level

GMO: (-3 outputs): applications are under stop the clock procedure; MS reports on Environmental Risk Assessment not delivered within agreed timelines

DCM: (-13 outputs): internal reports of DATEX contributing to opinions not included anymore on the statistics; some external reports will run into 2012.
