- Technical Groups (TGs)
- Objective:
 - ❖To provide specific information about TR implementation
 - To gather input in specific technical area -consultation and no cocreation
- 2 TGs established to date:
 - TG IUCLID for pesticides
 - TG Notification of Studies database
 - Composition: Member States, ECHA, industry stakeholders
 - 2 meetings to date (1 physical in November 2019, 1 virtual in February 2020)

Technical groups II



- TG IUCLID for pesticides: use of IUCLID modules for pesticides dossier handling
 - Composition: Member States, ECHA, industry stakeholders
 - Meetings:
 - o 2 meetings to date (1 physical in November 2019, 1 virtual in February 2020)
 - Good progress and discussions; participants engage and provide valuable feedback to EFSA – EFSA considers comments but ensures no undue influence
 - Regular virtual meetings to allow continuation of discussions
 - o 2nd meeting planned for April 2020
- TG Notification of Studies database:
 - Composition: Stakeholders (Industry, NGO, Consumer organisation, Practitioners), Member States, DG SANTE, EMA
 - Meetings
 - o 1st physical meeting on 20-21 February
 - Good discussion and valuable/relevant feedback received on practical aspect of the proposed workflow and practical example when commissioning studies to laboratory/facilities
 - o Regular virtual meetings to allow continuation of discussions
 - o 2nd meeting planned for September 2020
