

EFSA Technical Group on IUCLID for PESTICIDES

- Nov 2019 – June 2021
- Representatives of 7 MSs, IND
- Future work: Developing and testing new features and format

EFSA IUCLID Hypercare programme

- Nov 2020 – Nov 2021
- Representatives of all MSs (RMS for selected substances as active participants, all other MS as observers), IND
- User driven prioritisation of amendments for inclusion in future IUCLID releases
- Identification of potential issues that need further development, to be channeled to the [IUCLID backlog](#)



- **What?** Create a sub-group of the EFSA Pesticide Steering Network.
- **When?** First meeting in first half 2021
- **Who?** MSs will be invited to nominate an expert with good IUCLID and/or electronic dossier expertise.
- **Scope?**
 - Yearly meeting: Present upcoming changes to IUCLID prior to the next version release date.
 - In between meetings: written consultations on proposed changes resulting from development work of EFSA Technical Group on IUCLID.
 - Channel all requests for changes coming from pesticides submissions to the OECD IUCLID User Group Expert Panel who is the body deciding on the IUCLID changes.

- Under Transparency Regulation: Increasing MS cooperation and establishment of Partnerships with MS
- Input and support from MS is essential to further develop IUCLID, make best use of structured data in risk assessment workflow and optimise the preparation of DAR, RAR, ER.
- Current pilot grant contract with BfR to support EFSA in pending mamtox and residues OHT revisions and other IUCLID documents, establish further validation rules, work on interoperability solutions with Metapath and RUEDIS.
- New tasking grant call is under preparation, including for MS support on IUCLID.
- Interest from MS?
