Request for the provision of technical assistance in the field of risk

I would like to submit a formal request to EFSA for the provision of technical assistance in the field of risk communication.

Article 1 point 2 of Regulation (EU) 2019/1381 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 June 2019 on the transparency and sustainability of the EU risk assessment in the food chain ("Transparency Regulation") amongst others introduces a new Article Sc to Regulation (EC) No 178/2002 (hereinafter "General Food Law Regulation).

The latter new provision empowers the Commission to adopt, by means of an implementing act, a general plan for risk communication in order to achieve the objectives and the general principles set out in the General Food Law Regulation, as amended by the Transparency Regulation.²

The general plan should establish an integrated, flexible, transparent, continuous and inclusive risk communication framework for all EU and national risk assessors and risk managers. Particular emphasis should be placed on explaining in an accurate, clear, comprehensive, coherent and timely manner risk assessment findings, how those are used

World Food Safety Day!

The first ever World Food Safety Day (WFSD) was celebrated on 7 June 2019 to draw attention and inspire action to help prevent, detect and manage foodborne risks, contributing to food security, human health, economic prosperity, agriculture, market access, tourism and sustainable development.

The United Nations General Assembly declared 7 June 2019 would be the first ever <u>World Food Safety Day</u>, in a December 2018 resolution. The UN food and health bodies – Codex Alimentarius, the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) and the World Health Organization (WHO) – created this special day to raise awareness about food safety issues and to contribute to the UN's development goals.


