- Broader expertise of MB members
- More prominent role for inter-agency cooperation

## *End to End Support Services*



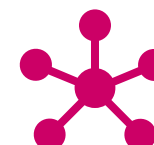
It aims at implementing tasks deriving from Regulation 178 related to confidentiality decision-making, on reactive transparency under Public Access to Document and Aarhus regulation and the new management Board.

It aims at providing staffing for RA as of 2020, to implement 178. It will redesign organigramme aligning it with optimized processes, supporting EFSA Strategy 2027.

## *End to End Science*

It aims at implementing new Regulation 178 measures into all science processes from End-to-End. It also addresses future risk assessment challenges through an optimisation of these processes ensuring integration of scientific developments, harmonisation, efficiency and responsiveness.

## *Engagement and Risk Communication*

It aims at developing engagement and partnering mechanisms with EFSA's Stakeholders, in line with the new science approach and the implementation of a general plan for risk communication, in support of Regulation 178. It will provide communication tools and processes for the delivery of consistent messages.

## Managing time-frame and expectations

Translate the law into procedures in collaboration with SANTE: data format, processes for data-work-flow, register of studies, transparency, confidentiality...

Prepare implementation (including development of necessary supporting tools)

Start delivering the added value enshrined in the new 178 GFL

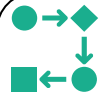
