Given by the legislation – general food law, horizontal legislation – e.g. food hygiene, official controls Specific legislation on FIA's (CAP, R. 1331/2008, R. 234/2011, R. 562/2012) and on enzymes (R. 1332/2008, R. 1056/2012) – scope, conditions of use, labelling, register, Union list
