




FIPRONIL IN EGGS | TIMELINE





- 30 August Standing Committee on Plants, Animals, Food and Feed (SC PAFF) Section Novel Food and Toxicological Safety of the Food Chain.
- Agreed ad-hoc data collection on residues of fipronil and other substances' potentially illegally used (about 50 chemicals).
- Monitoring will focus on domestic, fresh produces



- Early September scope and reporting requirements discussed
- 7 September EFSA finalised guidance document on monitoring data coding and reporting
- ad hoc data collection opened on 13 September and will close on 30 November



- 26 September high-level meeting (Ministerial Conference).
- 19 measures aimed at reinforcing the EU's action against food fraud

Some comments from high-level meeting:

- 1. EFSA as a source of good advice also in support of management issues.
- Central coordination at Member State level required - single contact point for RASSF and Administrative and cooperation systems (AAC)
- 3. Possible **Food Safety Chief Officer** like the CVO's and CPO's.
- 4. Need to improve Risk Communication,
 Monitoring of Residues and Risk Management
 Coordination.



MANDATE ON FIPRONIL

- 28 September EC request for technical assistance (Article 31 of Regulation (EC) No 178/2002) for
 - ad-hoc data collection on fipronil and other substances' residues in eggs and poultry meat/fat and
 - 2. a Scientific Report on the reported findings.



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
