





One Health Concept


"An integrated approach for preventing and mitigating health threats at the Animal-Human-Plant-Environment interfaces with the objective of achieving public health, food and nutrition security, sustainable ecosystems and fair trade facilitation"





of emerging infectious diseases of humans (including Ebola, HIV, and influenza) have an animal origin





Implemented through:

- Studies of the interfaces humans, animals and their environments,
- By mobilizing both communities Med and Vet,
- Into multidisciplinary works.






Initial findings

- "No border": public health and foodborne risks can only be tackled at international level
- Veterinary, medical and food safety sciences independently organized and scattered, located in various science institutes and financed by different ministries, leading to possible duplication of efforts and activities
- Only a "One Health" approach can compensate and help tackle the issue of foodborne diseases by linking human and animal heath, food safety and the environmental health together

Global framework


- EJP « One Health » : a European research project
- Main objective is to reinforce links between animal health, human health and environmental health and sciences: "One health"
- Co-financed by the European Commission and the Member States (5 years , 90 €M)
- Main missions:
 - Joint pogramming of National research programmes
 - Financing of such programmes
- Research topics of interest are defined by research institutes after consultation of RA national agencies and Efsa

EJP « One Health » contributes to aligning and integrating strategies and expertise of both veterinary, medical and food institutes.


