

The aim of the project

In order to further improve the automation process, this project aims to explore possibilities for integrated approach to literature search and relevance screening



March 2019 – where are we now?

- Work package 1 Shiny R tool
 - Statistically based tool
- Work package 2 citation networks
 - a collection of nodes (individual articles) and how they link to other articles through either referring to them or being referred to by them
- Work package 3 ontology based information extraction system
 - a collection of tools that eventually rank screened documents according to their relevance and enable their meta-analysis



Financing

Horizon 2020

- Policy support activities, including benchmarking activities, evaluation and impact assessments, the development of ad hoc support software, possibly using existing Framework Contracts. DG CONNECT plans to procure via framework contracts and calls for tender indicatively 10 contracts before the end of 2019. The calls for tenders are expected to be launched in the 2nd and 3rd calendar quarter of 2018 and 2019
