


In the harmonised chemical monitoring data collection guidelines (SSD2) on page 29 M.05 resLOQ is a mandatory element although in previous data collections e.g. VMPR, it was dependent mandatory. Since this has been identified as difficult for some data providers, the XSD has been modified so absence of resLOQ in a data transmission will remain as a warning for 2018 data collection and will become an error from 2019.

Since resLOQ is useful when handling left censored data in exposure assessments this is something we would like to achieve although it may not be fully possible for all data providers in 2018 data transmissions.


