# Actions stemming from the Reflection Paper

1. Improvement in the organisation of technical meetings: Ongoing. Rolling Work Plan distributed in the documents tabled at the meeting.
2. Breakout sessions: Ongoing. One plenary meeting of the Platform dedicated at breakout sessions. Successful feedback of the communication breakout sessions organized in June. To be repeated once a year.
3. Presentations of Stakeholders Members: the proposal implies to increase presentations made by members (agenda-Secretariat). Example will follow with presentations by Platform members on GLP studies.
4. Scientific discussions of EFSA's Panels on horizontal issues: the proposal implies opening to stakeholders' observers. EFSA is currently looking into the possibility of opening up the meeting of its Scientific Committee and Panels when horizontal matters are discussed.

# The Stakeholders Extranet Platform

- The creation of the Stakeholders Extranet Platform: implementation ongoing.
- EFSA is designing the Extranet Platform that will be operational by the end of year.
- The Extranet Platform will allow uploading documents, exchange of messages, consulting a common calendar, exchanging information.
- Access permitted only to members of the Platform and EFSA staff dedicated to it.

# The Stakeholders Extranet Platform

- The access and navigation in this virtual space is done via any Internet browser, and each stakeholders will be given a User ID and Password to enter to SHP extranet;
- The Extranet Platform will allow to upload documents
- Update a Calendar – providing the members with the meetings schedule
- Announcements – giving the possibility to follow up on the announcements for various projects
