

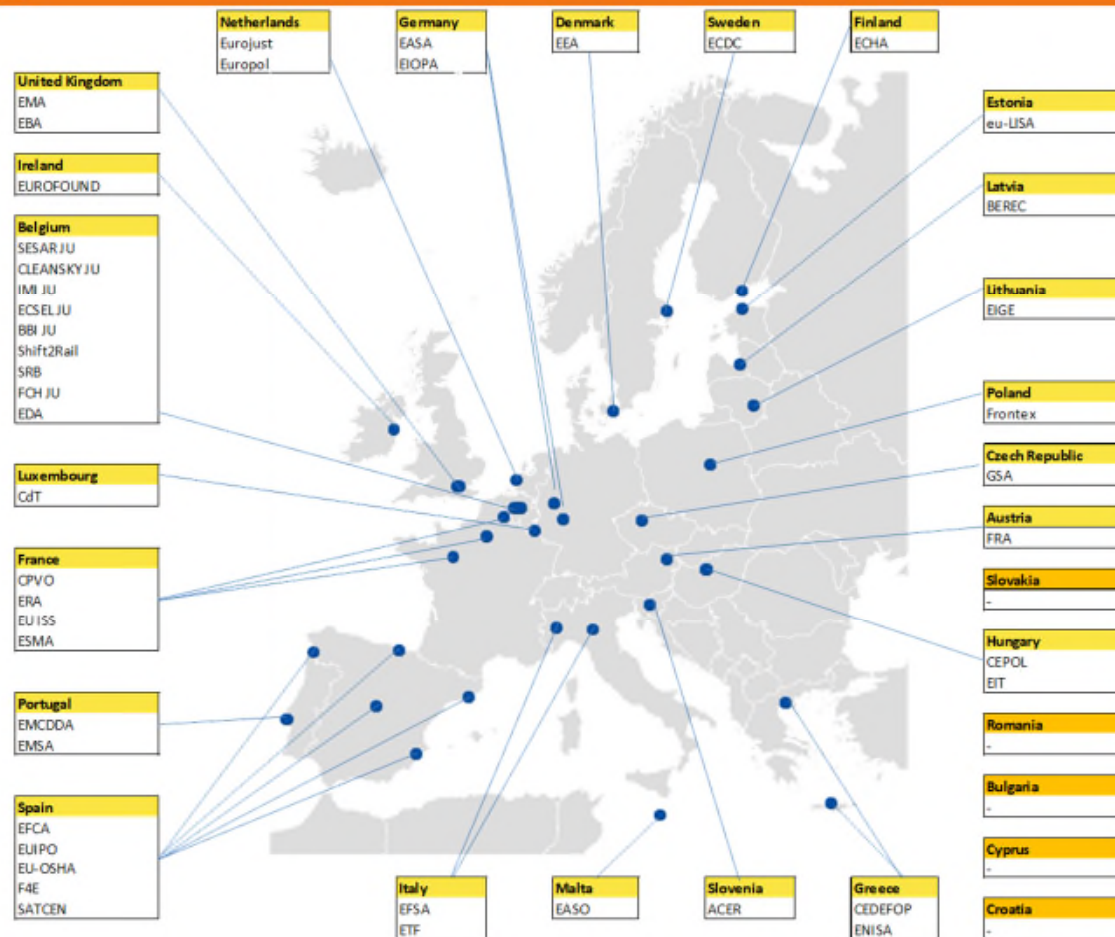

Network of Agencies

Objectives:

- improve effectiveness and efficiency;
- streamline administrative and organisational issues;
- facilitate interactions on governance and resource allocation;
- help Agencies find a unified voice on points of common interest.

Under Focus 2017-2018 (EFSA chair):

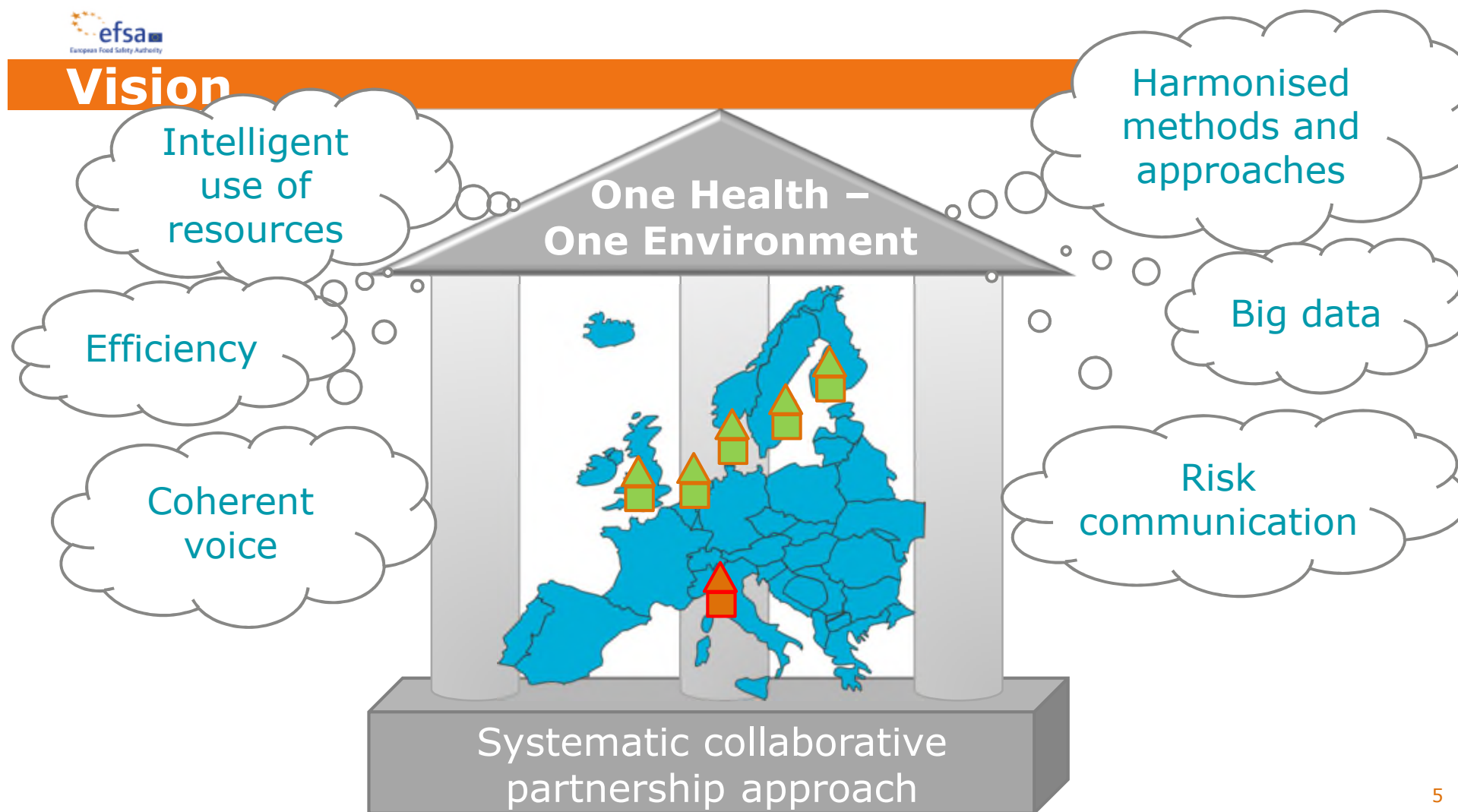
- Sharing services and capabilities

EFSA Strategy 2020

1. Prioritise public engagement in the process of scientific assessment
2. Widen EFSA's evidence base and maximise access to its data
3. Build the EU's scientific assessment capacity and knowledge community
 - Set up and implement a common risk assessment and research agenda with Member States and EU agencies, in collaboration with international partners
 - Foster the growth of the EU and international risk assessment community
 - Review and further develop EFSA's scientific assessment model
4. Prepare for future risk assessment challenges
5. Create an environment and culture that reflects EFSA's values

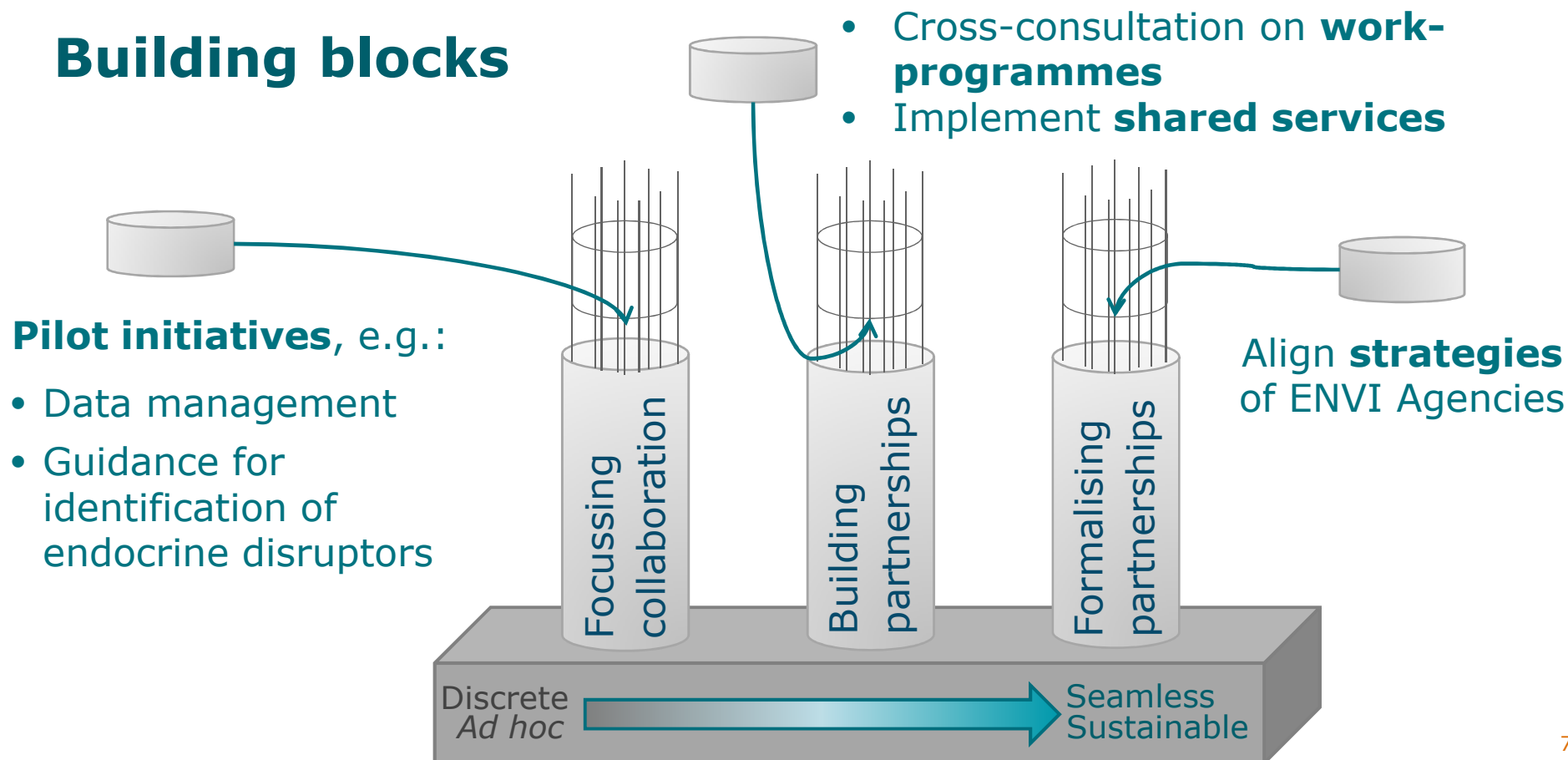

Collaboration with ECHA

- Compilation of a **Guidance Document** for the identification of **Endocrine Disruptors**

- **European Parliament data initiative** on harmonisation of chemical safety data between Agencies
 - ENVI WG on safety data established in 2017
 - Strong political support for a feasibility study on a common open platform on chemical safety data to increase and simplify access to the data collections held by the agencies
 - Pilot project to be financed under 2019 EU budget

What next?

- Implementation: Coordination, steering across EFSA
- Identify new joint initiatives, via:
 - currently identified cooperation activities
 - workshops-discussion with other ENVI Agencies
 - cross-consultation of work-programmes
- Organise a common strategy workshop with ENVI Agencies
- Gradually align the strategies of all cooperating parties
