




P3 2018 PERFORMANCE SNAPSHOT

Total # of Performance Indicators in the Programming Document 132

Indicators **reported** in the reporting period **71**



Out of 71 indicators measured in the P3, **49 (69%) indicators** registered results that **met or surpassed the targets set**. This result is below what achieved in the first 2 Periods of 2018 (80% and 73%, respectively).

Different reasons behind the 61 indicators not reported in this Period:

- they are under definition/awaiting a baseline to be set
- their measurement occurs with an yearly frequency
- technical problems prevented the measurement

Indicators **not reported** in the reporting period **61**



KPI DEFINITION IN 2018


