



Boost innovation for safe and sustainable chemicals




ACTIONS

Simplify and consolidate the legal framework – One Substance One Assessment



Problem formulation covering uses of substance(s) under different chemical frameworks







Increased role of the Classification, Labelling and Packaging Regulation whithin food/feed regulatory frameworks



Cross-cutting methodologies co-developed by the relevant EU agencies and MSs







Establishment of common transversal expert working groups on cross-cutting topic



Harmonisation of the expert selection processes







EU - Common open platform on chemical safety data

Health issue: infection in human with *Aspergillus* spp. resistant to treatment with azoles (ECDC, EMA)




Use of azoles in the environment:
