

Assessment of the interests declared by the members of the Management Board pursuant to Article 37(1) of the Regulation (EC) No 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council

The present note provides an assessment on whether the interests declared by Board members represent a potential conflict in accordance with EFSA's internal rules and the Board Code of Conduct. Based on this assessment, the Board should reach a conclusion and where appropriate recommend a follow-up.

If an identified conflict that is substantially affecting the work of the Board or EFSA's reputation is not resolved by the proposed assessment and a member of the Board is not fulfilling his/her obligations in relation to independence in such a manner that this is substantially affecting the work of the Board, the Board, acting on a two-thirds majority, may ask for his or her replacement¹.

Gergana BALIEVA – Management Board alternate member representing Bulgaria

Assessment: Since July 2024, Prof. Balieva is a member of the working group of the Bulgarian Ministry of Agriculture and Food tasked to draft legislation in the area of veterinary professional associations. The activities carried out by Prof. Balieva are performed in the public interest and do not entail the implementation of risk assessment or risk management activities in areas pertaining to the remit of EFSA. Prof. Balieva's consultancy activity in favour of the Bulgarian Ministry of Agriculture and Food does not constitute a conflict of interest. Since January 2024, Prof. Balieva is engaged in research activities focused on the use of computer technology for the identification of animals, which are funded by the Trakia University. The research activities are supported by funds of public nature and do not constitute conflicts of interests.
