1. WELCOME, APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Seppo Salminen.

2. ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

4. MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS PLENARY MEETING

The chair informed the Panel about the current status of the request on *trans* fatty acids. An *ad hoc* working group has been established and a rapporteur has been appointed for this task. The expected date of completion of this task is June 2004.

5. CO-ORDINATION WITH EFSA SCIENTIFIC COMMITTEE AND OTHER EFSA PANELS

The chair briefed the Panel on the outcome of previous meetings of the EFSA Scientific Committee, and particularly, concerning reconsideration of existing opinions whenever new scientific information might require so. The Scientific Committee advised the Panels to take a pro-active approach when considering this issue.

6. GENERAL INFORMATION BY EFSA ON MATTERS RELATED TO THE PANEL

The scientific co-ordinator updated the Panel on the most recent developments of the move of EFSA to Parma.

The outcome about the EFSA Colloque was distributed to the Panel. The last amendment to the rules of procedure in relation to the adoption of minutes by written procedure was also distributed to the Panel.

The scientific co-ordinator briefed the Panel about the call for expression of interests for membership of the Panel. The call has been published on the EFSA web site with a closing date of 15 March 2004.

7. NEW REQUESTS FOR SCIENTIFIC OPINIONS

7.1 Vegetable oils high in unsaponifiable matter

A new request for scientific opinion has been received from the Commission on two novel food applications concerning vegetable oils (maize-germ oil and rapeseed oil) high in unsaponifiable matter. This request has been allocated to the Working Group on Novel Foods. As additional information has been now requested to the applicant, the expected date of completion of this request is 3 months after the receipt of the additional information requested.

8. DIETETIC PRODUCTS

8.1 Draft opinion on goats' milk protein as a protein source for infant formulae and follow-on formulae

The chair of the Working Group on Infant Formula introduced the draft opinion. The opinion was adopted subject to the incorporation of modifications agreed upon by the Panel
