The EU bodies involved are: European Commission, EFSA, EMEA (European Medicines Agency), ECDC (European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control), EEA (European Environment Agency) and EMCDDA (European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction). The objective of the meeting is to discuss how to improve cooperation between different scientific bodies established under Community law and European Commission services, which issue scientific opinions and carry out similar tasks, and to exchange view.

5. GENERAL INFORMATION BY EFSA ON MATTERS RELATED TO THE PANEL

In relation to the renewal of the membership for the EFSA's Scientific Committee and Scientific Panels which takes place in 2006, the Panel was informed about the procedure and timetable of the Call for expressions of interest in membership which is now published in the official journal and the EFSA website. The deadline of application is 7 January 2006. Panel members were asked to assist in disseminating the call to expert who may be interested.
