4. Scientific topic(s) for discussion

4.1. Requirements for the development of microbiological criteria³

The Working Group discussed the self-tasking mandate received from the BIOHAZ Panel. The approach to answer all terms of reference (ToR 1 to ToR 4) was thoroughly discussed. An overview of all the previous EFSA Scientific Opinions/Reports related to microbiological criteria was provided to the WG and the WG experts agreed to do a critical review of these documents in order to answer to ToR 1. When addressing ToR 2, the WG will provide practical and useful guidance to the BIOHAZ Panel as risk assessors in future requests related to microbiological criteria. This guidance should allow the BIOHAZ Panel to address future requests in a more consistent and harmonised way. Issues such as the (i) the possible lack of data, (ii) knowledge gaps and (iii) how to deal with uncertainties when dealing with requests related to microbiological criteria will also be addressed. A review of the most important and useful available methods/tools to design microbiological criteria will be performed based on the knowledge and expertise of the WG members in order to answer to ToR 3.

It was clarified with the European Commission that this mandate does not intend to review any microbiological criteria currently defined in the EU regulation nor to propose new ones and that the focus of this mandate will be on risk assessment methodologies.

The preliminary table of contents of the draft scientific opinion was agreed and tasks were allocated to EFSA staff and Working group experts. The Working Group discussed the opportunity to hold a technical consultation with relevant stakeholders further ahead to gather information useful for the development of the Scientific Opinion (in particular to answer to ToR

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4). It was also agreed to expand the WG by inviting an additional expert from the reserve list which was prepared when establishing this WG.

5. Next meeting
