## 4. Scientific topics for discussion

### 4.1. Re-evaluation of Polydextrose (E 1200) (EFSA-Q-2011-00583)

Data submitted on the solubility of polydextrose (E 1200) by interested business operators were assessed. When assessing the data, the Working Group considered the proposed decision criteria described in the EFSA "*Draft Guidance on technical requirement for regulated food and feed product applications*" (available on the EFSA web-site)<sup>3</sup>, published for public consultation, to decide whether additional data are needed to demonstrate that consumers will not be exposed to small particles of polydextrose when used as E 1200. The assessment of the available data will be further considered for the re-evaluation of this food additive at the EFSA Working Group on the re-evaluation of miscellaneous food additives.<sup>4</sup>

### 4.2. Re-evaluation of Neohesperidine DC (E 959) (EFSA-Q-2011- 00726)

Data submitted on the solubility and particle size of the material from the different interested business operators were discussed and the assessment of the data was prepared. The assessment of the data will be further considered for the re-evaluation of this food additive at the EFSA Working Group on the re-evaluation of sweeteners.<sup>5</sup>
